Try this quick way to find a journal article citation in MEDICOR using Citation Linker.

Here's How To Do It

1. Go to the Medicor home page <http://spcmsmedicor.org/>
2. Under "Start With Favorites" about half-way down, choose "Click here to use Citation Linker"
3. If you have not already logged-in, you will be asked to do so
4. The Citation Linker window will appear
5. Type in the information you have available such as journal title, volume, issue and start page
6. Click GO
7. Click the red swirly SFX button next to the correct journal title, in this case: "The Laryngoscope (Full text)"
8. The SFX services window will appear indicating that a full text version of the article is available (if no services are available, please check to be sure you have chosen your correct hospital affiliation from the pull-down menu. The other option is that the hospital's medical library does not subscribe to that journal...check the A-Z list of journals for subscription information)
9. Click the GO button
10. The Journal table of contents or your article will appear.
