To All Medicor Registered Users

One of the most important ways of keeping up to date is by browsing and reading general and specialty medical journals in your field. Even if these journals are in electronic format, it's important to continue to browse and read these titles, even without the journal physically in front of you. This is where tables of contents email alerting services can be very helpful. A majority of these services are FREE.

Here's How To Do It

Nearly every publisher of biomedical journals supplies an email alerting service for tables of contents, freely, even though you (or your library) may not have a subscription to the full content. For example, the New England Journal of Medicine offers an email alerting service at [this Web address](#).

To find out what electronic journals are available to you through Medicor, simply browse your library's A-Z list of electronic journals by [clicking here](#). You can locate journals by typing in a portion of the title, as well as by subject category. Choosing "Category" then "Health Sciences" will reveal numerous subcategories of journals such as "Cardiology", "Orthopaedics", or "Preventive Medicine". When you find a journal of interest, just click on the title to go directly to the table of contents for current or back issues. To store the journal for future reference in your "My Space>My e-Journals" list, click on the plus (+) sign below the journal title.

If you are affiliated with the Health Sciences Library at Sacred Heart Medical Center, you may be able to request copies of articles not available through Medicor via interlibrary loan. The contact information for Sandy Keno, your medical librarian, is below.
